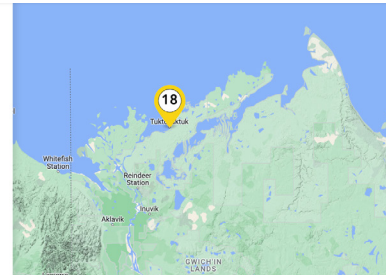
18. Tuktoyaktuk Community Climate Resiliency (AIP)

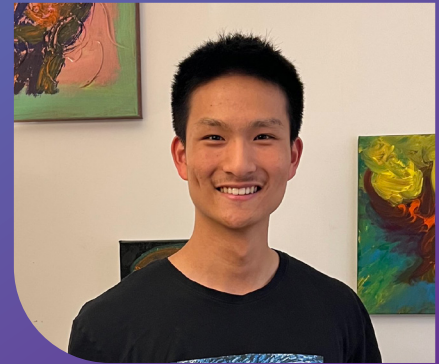

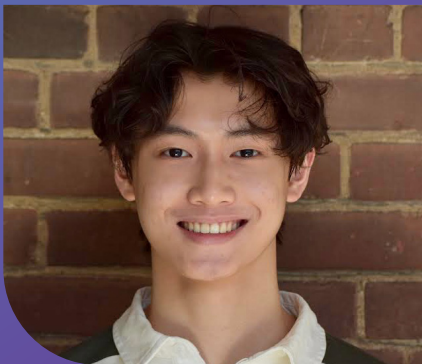
